



COVID - 19 Decision Tree Approved 08/09/2021

STUDENT



Have you had close contact with someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 or have you had close contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) with a person **WITH A MORE COMMON SYMPTOM OR MULTIPLE LESS COMMON SYMPTOMS** of COVID-19?

Do you have any ***SYMPTOMS**?

Attend school as normal.

YES

Were you wearing a mask or have you been fully vaccinated?

NO

Isolate for 7 days and then test for Covid-19 after the 5th day. If negative, return to attending school, wear a mask through 14 days after exposure, and have daily temperature checks at school. If ***SYMPTOMS** appear, seek the evaluation of a medical provider.

YES

Attend school and monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If contact was with a member of the household, self-isolate for 10 days.

YES

Seek the evaluation of a medical provider to determine if COVID-19 testing is necessary. **If testing is necessary, please ISOLATE until test results are received.**
If test result is **POSITIVE**, continue to **ISOLATE** and a local public health official will contact you to follow up.
If no testing is conducted, you should ISOLATE for at least 10 days after symptom onset AND until symptoms have improved, including being fever-free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medications.

*SYMPTOMS MAY APPEAR 2-14 DAYS AFTER EXPOSURE TO THE VIRUS AND INCLUDE:
