### Quick Facts

- 135 student attending in person classes in SWDH has tested positive for COVID-19 over the past 7 days.
- 1,148 students attending in person classes in SWDH have tested positive for COVID-19 during the 2021-2022 school year.
- 28 teachers working in person in SWDH tested positive for COVID-19 during the past 7 days.
- 202 teachers working in person in SWDH tested positive for COVID-19 during the 2021-2022 school year.
